



Navtech ranked 366th Fastest Growing Technology Company in North America on Deloitte's 2008 Technology Fast 500

Waterloo, November 12, 2008 – Navtech today announced that it ranked number 366 on Deloitte's 2008 Technology Fast 500, a ranking of the 500 fastest growing technology, media, telecommunications and life sciences companies in North America. Rankings are based on percentage of fiscal year revenue growth over five years, from 2003–2007. Navtech grew 371% percent during this period.

Navtech's President & CEO, David Strucke, credits innovative products and expertise with the company's 371% revenue growth over the past five years. He said, "This second honour from Deloitte in 2008 is very poignant. Navtech has had great success as of late and to be recognized for our financial standings with other North American technology companies is keeping great company."

In addition to ranking on Deloitte's Technology Fast 500, Navtech ranked #38 on the Canadian Technology Fast 50, which is a ranking of the 50 fastest growing technology firms in Canada.

The Fast 500 ranks the fastest growing technology, media, telecommunications and life sciences companies in North America. It is compiled from Deloitte's regional North American Fast 50 programs, nominations submitted directly to the Fast 500, and public company database research. Companies are selected based on percentage revenue growth from 2003 to 2007.

Entrants must own proprietary intellectual property or proprietary technology that contributes to a significant portion of the company's operating revenues or devote a significant proportion of revenues to research and development of technology. Using other companies' technology or intellectual property in a unique way does not qualify. Base-year operating revenues must be at least \$50,000 USD or \$75,000 CD, and current-year operating revenues must be at least \$5 million USD or CD. Companies must be in business a minimum of five years, and they must be headquartered within North America.
